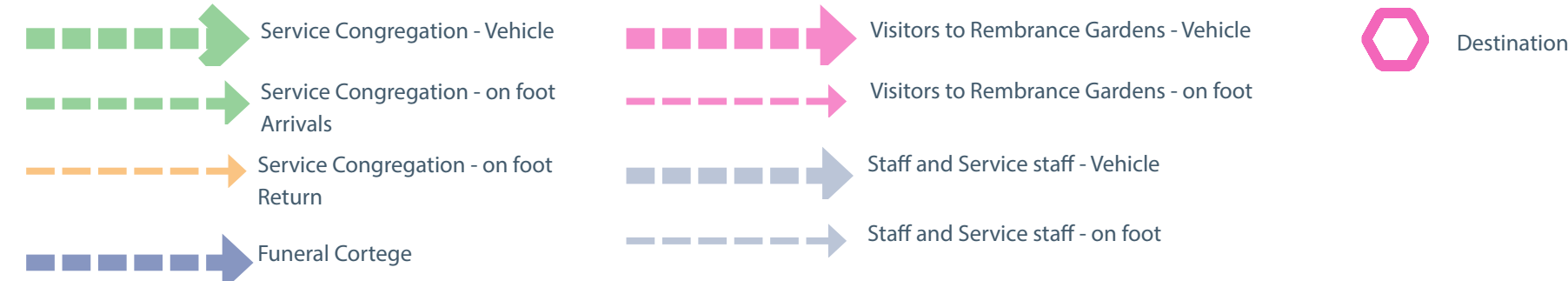

Site Circulation



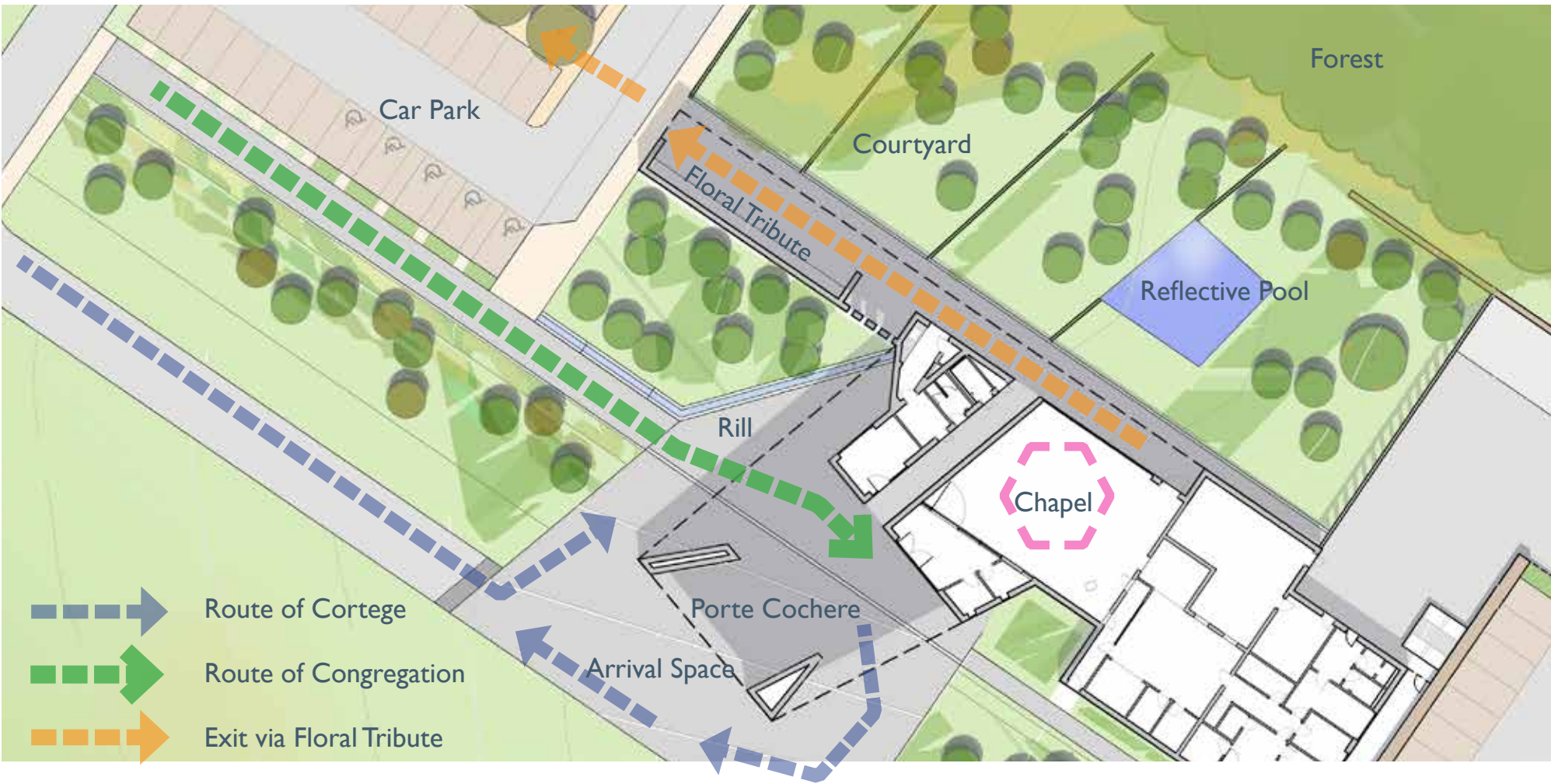

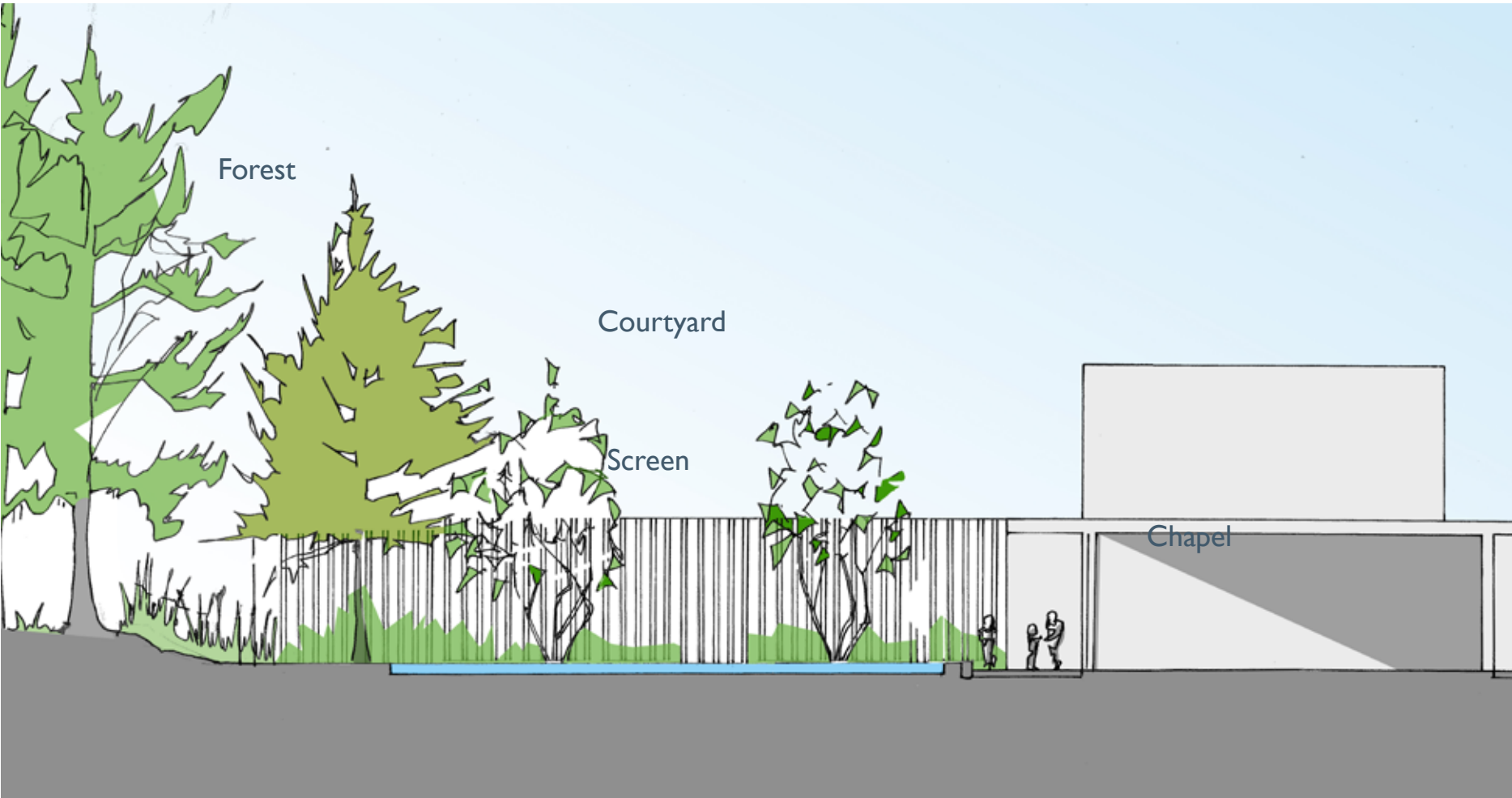
Arrival



On arrival the congregation is directed along the main axis path; a linear water feature and a series of gardens create a sequence of experiences leading toward the main arrival space and the entrance to the Chapel.



The Courtyard

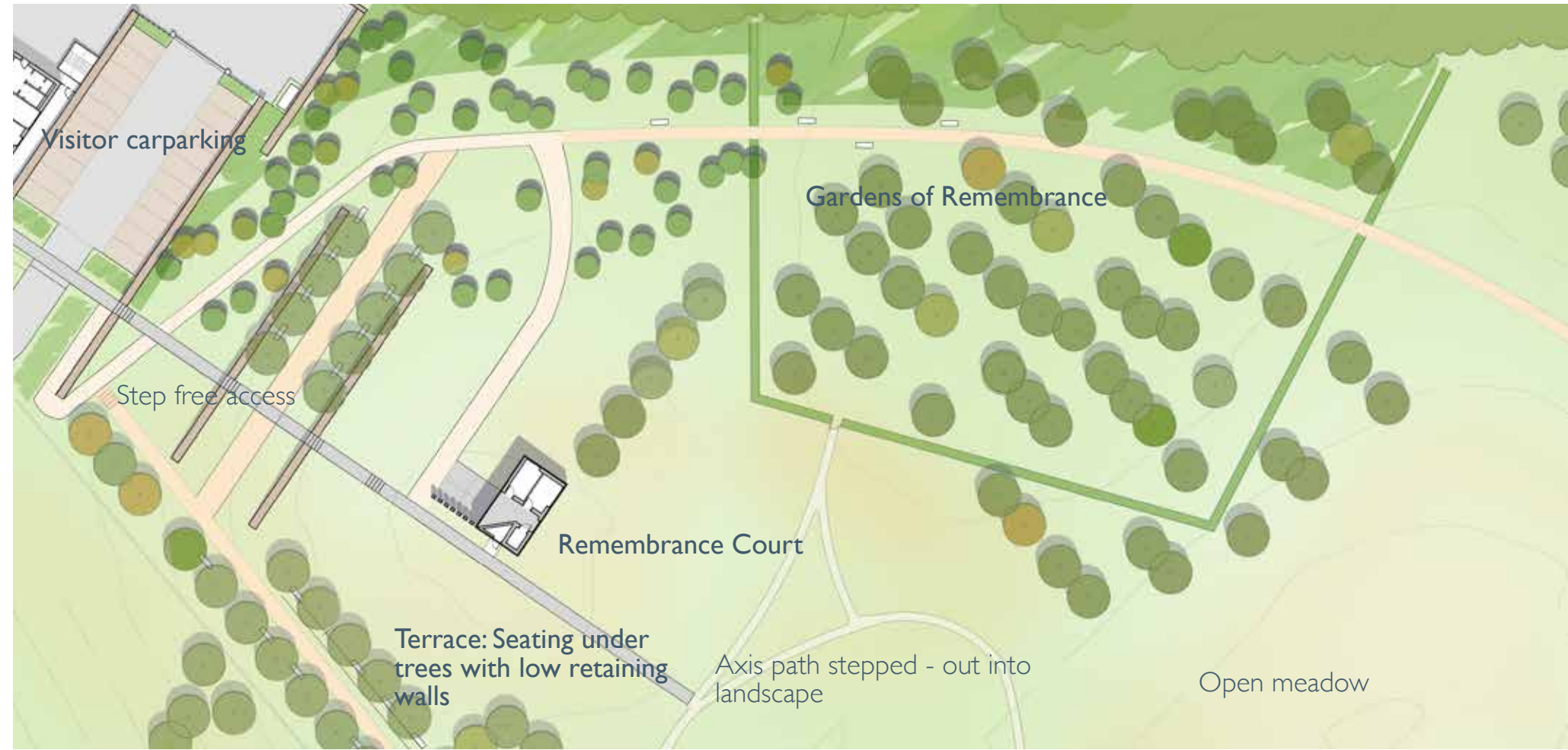


Framed between the Chapel and the Forest the Courtyard space forms the backdrop to Chapel services and is the area entered when the service is complete.

The main features of the space are the mature forest backdrop and a large reflective pool, providing a calming and peaceful outlook from the chapel.



Gardens of Remembrance



To the east of the site the main path leads up steps to the remembrance court.

Low walls create terraced level garden areas, calm spaces with views out over the landscape and the river valley.

An enclosed area, a 'Garden of Remembrance' is set aside for the placing of ashes and the creation of memorial plaques or tributes.
