
The LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

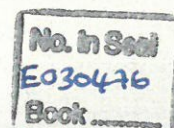
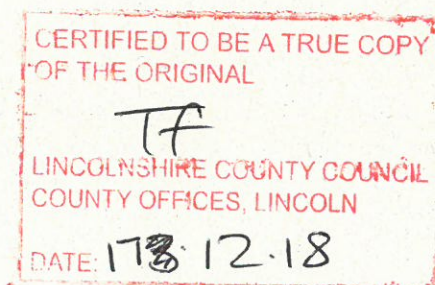
1. This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Dunholme – Lincoln Road) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2018 and shall come into operation on **21 December 2018**.

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.

PUBLIC NOTICE

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DUNHOLME – LINCOLN ROAD) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council has made an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the existing 30mph speed limit on Lincoln Road, Dunholme to the A46.

The Order will come into operation on **21 December 2018** and a copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a Statement of Reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the offices of Lincolnshire County Council, Lancaster House, 36 Orchard Street, Lincoln, LN1 1XX, and the offices of West Lindsey District Council, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks after 17 December 2018 make application to the High Court for this purpose.
