VOTING

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on Tuesday 3 March 2020. Register on-line at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote

Postal Votes - New applications to vote by post, amendments to existing postal votes or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 4 March 2020.

Proxy Votes – New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 11 March 2020.

Emergency proxy applications, due to medical emergency or one relating to a service or work reason which occurs after 5pm on Wednesday 11 March, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 19 March 2020.
