CRITERIA FOR HONORARY ALDERMEN

The Criteria for an Alderman will be considered by the Chief Executive in conjunction with the Chairman's Officer prior to submission to Council.

- 1. Must be a Former Councillor of West Lindsey District Council
- 2. Candidates should have rendered eminent services by way of exceptional contribution to the district and it's Council in terms of length of service and, in particular, achievement whilst in office.
- 3. Must be considered suitable for fulfilling the role of an Honorary Alderman, and respected by their peers and communities.
- 4. Their achievement should be exemplary and ideally link to one of the themes within the Corporate Plan.
- 5. Must not have any know misdemeanours e.g. un-expired Criminal Record, outstanding standards board complaints.
- 6. Must be nominated in writing to the Chairman's Officer by a current serving Member of Council and seconded by a further serving Member of Council.
- 7. Must be approved by the Leader of the Council (or Leader of the Opposition dependant on the party of the nominee).
- 8. A proposition must be approved by two thirds of the present members at a meeting of Council called specifically for that sole purpose.
