Introduction

The purpose of this document

1. This document provides a record of the written notification to withdraw the designation of the Grayingham Neighbourhood Development Plan Area for the purposes of creating a neighbourhood plan.

Regulations and government guidance

2. The regulations associated with this stage of neighbourhood planning provide guidance on the criteria to be included for this phase. Within this statement, we as the local planning authority must publicise on our website:
 - a statement setting out details of the withdrawal (“the withdrawal statement”); and
 - details of where and when the withdrawal statement may be inspected

Background

3. West Lindsey District Council approved the application by **Grayingham Parish Meeting** to have the parish of Grayingham designated as a neighbourhood area, for the purposes of producing a neighbourhood plan on 20 December 2016.
4. **Grayingham Parish Meeting** formally requested to withdraw their designation for the parish area on **14th June 2017**.

Outcomes

5. West Lindsey District Council has accepted the request by **Grayingham Parish Meeting** to have the parish of Grayingham withdrawn as a neighbourhood area.
6. Any further applications by Grayingham Parish Meeting to designate their parish area for the purposes of producing a neighbourhood plan will require another formal request for designation.
