

Receipt of petition

West Lindsey District Council was presented with a petition on 15 February 2017.

The petition is entitled “Fiskerton Neighbourhood Plan” and contains over 300 signatures.

The Petition states: -

“The Fiskerton Neighbourhood Planning Group (NPG) will be submitting the final draft of the Fiskerton Neighbourhood Plan (NP) in the coming weeks. Throughout the development of this plan the NPG has continually expressed that their preferred option is to build North of Ferry Road and every time resident have raised concerns over the location or requested other site be investigated the NPG has dismissed their request.

We the undersigned, request that West Lindsey District Council hold an extraordinary meeting to examine and debate the content of the Fiskerton NP and the public consultation process that preceded it, prior to the NP being forwarded to the Planning Inspector. The desired outcome being the insistence of a democratic re-ballot to be held which equally and without bias, presents all possible NP options and consults all village residents.”

In accordance with the Petition Scheme this matter will be considered by a future meeting of Full Council, date to be confirmed.
