

Quantum Broadband brings another village into the digital age.

Quantum fibre broadband, one of Lincolnshire's local ISP, have recently extended their network into more areas, and thanks to the new modern network that's been installed, more and more people no longer have to rely on Fibre to the cabinet (FTTC), they can now enjoy the super-fast speeds, fibre brings them direct to their home (FTTP).

Like other rural areas across Lincolnshire, the residents of a small village called West Torrington were only able to receive FTTC, and speeds of around 10mbps some as low as just 2mbps, but thanks to the collaboration and efforts of Lincolnshire's Broadband councilor, West Lindsey's local broadband councilor and Quantum Fibre broadband, the residents of West Torrington, no longer have to suffer with poor broadband connectivity and are now able to receive and connect to full fibre broadband with speeds of up to 1000mbps.

Mr and Mrs Rupp, one of the first residents to go live in West Torrington, who only averaged around 8mbps, had this to say about Quantum.

"What an excellent service from Quantum broadband. The engineers were respectful of our home, taking off their boots, clearing up after the install and the speeds are even better than expected. There was a little glitch at the start, which is to be expected, however this was resolved very quickly. The charges are half of what we were paying BT, and the speeds are 3 times faster.
