

Is my waste going to the right place?

Did you know that by law, it's the responsibility of any commercial activity to manage the waste it produces? You have a legal "Duty of Care" that starts from the moment you produce the waste and continues until you give it to a licensed waste carrier to deal with. Make sure they supply you with the proper documents though, or you still may not be covered.

In order to be legally compliant with your Waste Duty of Care, your registered waste collector will issue you with Waste Transfer Notes, please check that you have these documents.
