
PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime & Policing Act 2014





The Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 59, 64 and 72 of the Act and under all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following order:

- Dog fouling occurring on any land which is open to the air, and to which the public have a right or entitlement of access to, whether paid or unpaid, within the District of West Lindsey, must be removed immediately by the person at that time in control of the dog.
 - Dog fouling must be properly disposed of in a general waste bin or dog waste bin
- A person in charge of a dog on land, if directed by an authorised officer, must produce a device or other suitable means of removing dog faeces and transporting it to a bin (whether or not the dog has defecated)

It is an offence for a person without reasonable excuse to fail to comply with this order. A person found to be in breach of this order is liable on summary conviction to a maximum penalty of a level 3 fine or to a fixed penalty notice of £75.
