Support for businesses continues through the **Think Local** branding which was established in 2021

We launched Business **Grants** focusing on sustainability, farm diversification and agri-tech (via UKSPF funding)

In July 2023, we launched 2 new **cycle routes** in partnership with Cycle Lincolnshire

£70,000 awarded to date as part of the **Large Village** Retail Grant scheme which launched in May 2023

Week-long THI **Heritage** Skills Festival held in Gainsborough during September 2023

West Burton to become a prototype fusion energy plant as a **STEP** bringing significant investment to the district

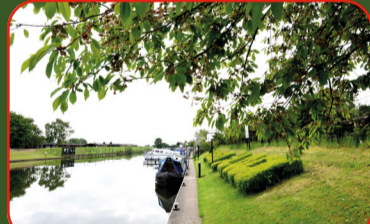
THI funding enabled **regeneration** works to 5-7 Market Place which is now home to an independent retailer
